What's Ahead in 2023

In that meeting, it was decided that 2023 is an "all or nothing" year; in other words, we're leaving it all on the table. We are determined to become more intimate with our members, with a goal of becoming more of a 'community' (of like-minded golfers) as opposed to just a 'league'-and offering more opportunities for CGT members to get together. With this in mind, check out what's ahead in 2023 below:

Aside from our 3 traditional tours, we're introducing (6) - 1 day tournaments. Each tournament will be a 2-Man Best Ball (net) tournament.

These tournaments will be taking place at already scheduled events, so CGT members will have the opportunity to play in both the day of tournament, as well as have their score go towards official scoring for said event-killing two birds with one stone. CGT members will have first crack at registration and then the field will be open to the public. Dates & locations are TBD.

Some notable operational changes going into effect:

- First 2 Events - Lift, Clean & Place
- Additional Slack Channels - Broken Down by Preferred Time of Play
- Flighted Handicaps
 - Flighted for the entirety of the season. Compete only against members in your flight, including Championship day
- Event Payouts & Championship Day Purse Restructured
- 2 Playoff Events

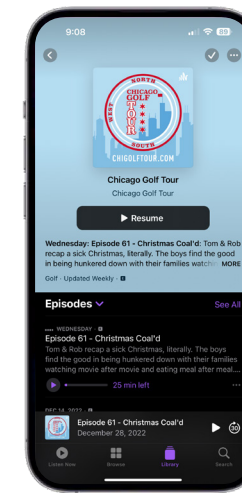
